

## **Creating a Family Plan**

Take time to prepare your loved ones for any disaster by creating a family communications plan. Plan how you will contact one another and where you'll go. Then, review your plan for different emergency situations.

Follow these steps to create your family's communications plan:

#### Step 1:

Ask an out-of-town friend to be your family contact. After a disaster, it's often easier to call long distance. This person may be in a better position to communicate among separated family members.

#### Step 2:

Every member of your family should have each emergency contact's phone number and coins or a prepaid phone card.

#### Step 3

Be patient when using the phone system, as the system could be busy or down altogether. Use your out-of-town contact to help coordinate when and how to meet.

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
